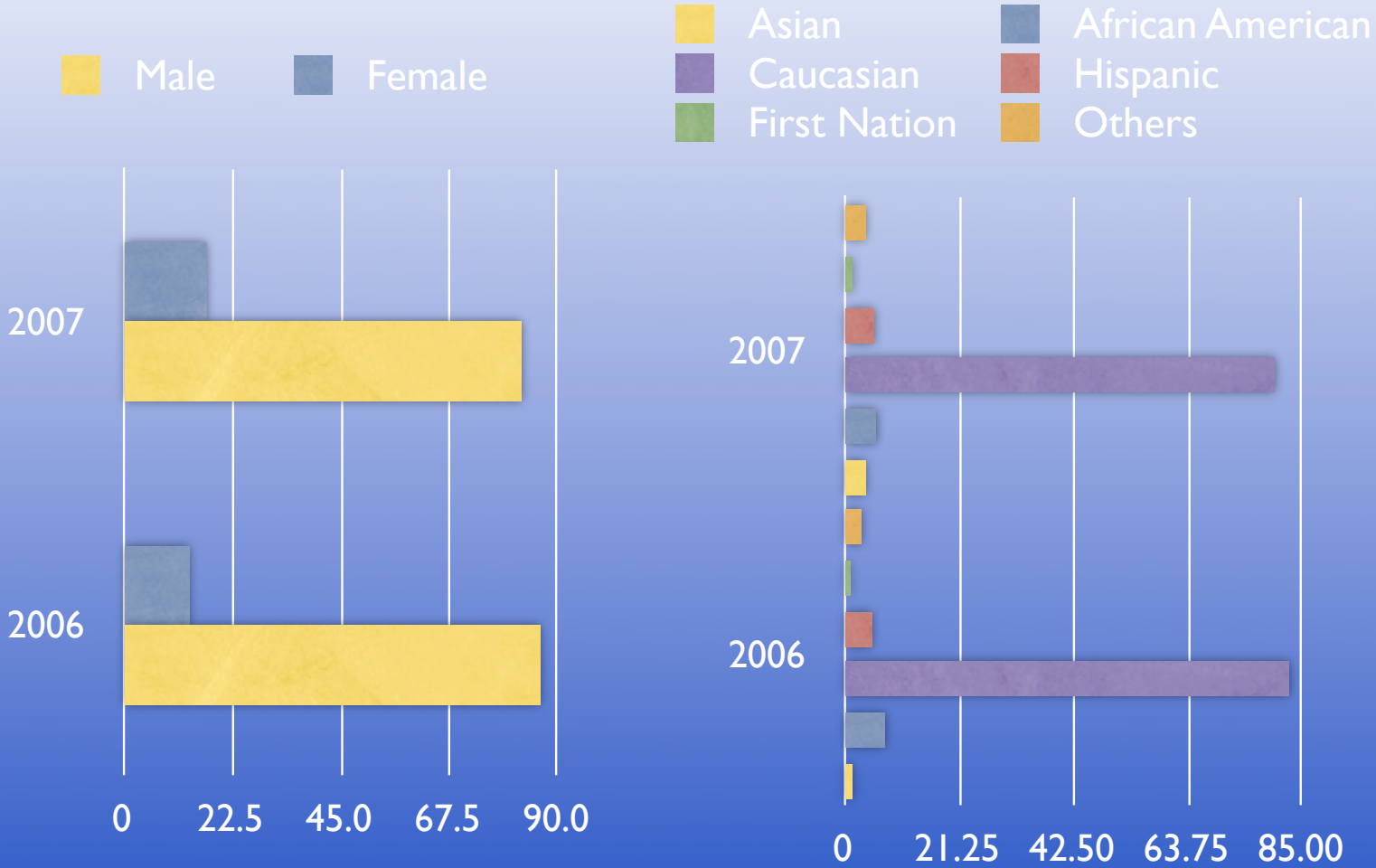
# Who...

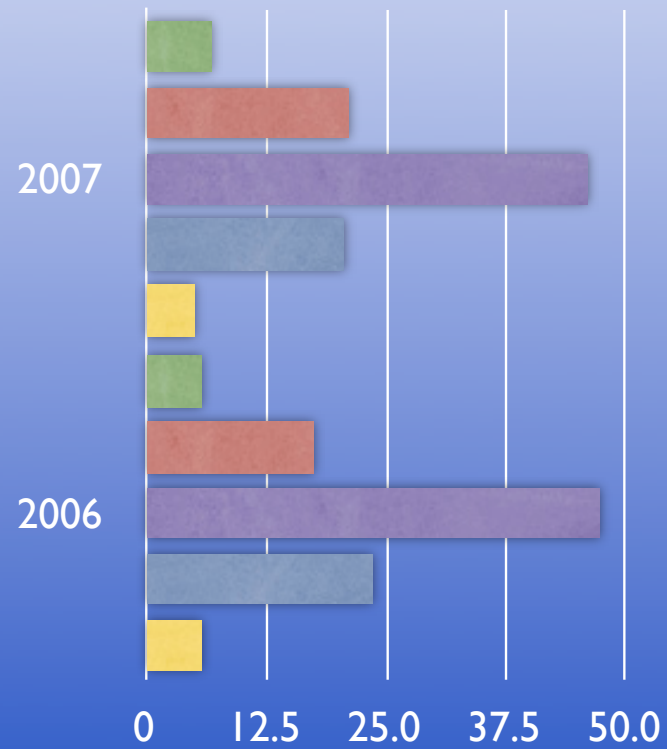
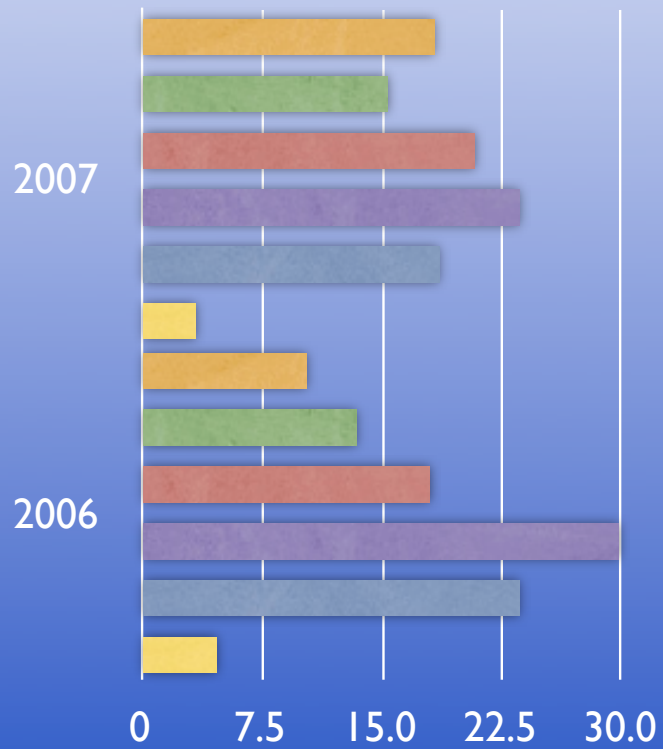
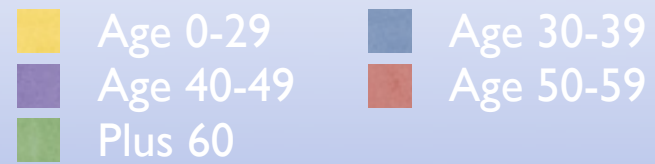
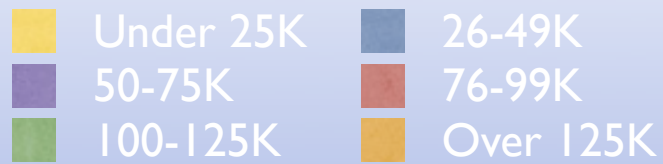
Founded in 1980 we have grown to over 11,000 members, 179 leagues and 65 tournaments representing the United States, Canada, Australia, and New Zealand.
